UONGOZI INSTITUTE TO HOLD ITS SEVENTH GRADUATION CEREMONY

17 May 2024, Dar es Salaam: UONGOZI Institute will hold its seventh graduation ceremony at the Mlimani City Conference Centre in Dar es Salaam, today. The event will be officiated by H.E. Dr. Jakaya Mrisho Kikwete, former President of the United Republic of Tanzania, and the patron of the Institute's African Leadership Forum.

Hon. George Simbachawene (MP), Minister of State in the President's Office – Public Service Management and Good Governance, will be in attendance. Dr. Lucy Surhley Newman, a renowned corporate governance expert, who now serves as Chief Executive Officer of Africa Private Sector Summit, will deliver a keynote address highlighting the importance of leadership development.

The event is organised to celebrate the accomplishments of those who have completed the Institute's long-term executive programmes: Postgraduate Diploma in Leadership (PGD), Certificate in Leadership (CiL), and Women's Leadership Programme (WLP). A total of 198 leaders will graduate.

The three programmes aim to develop leadership competencies in personal leadership, people leadership and organisational leadership. They are dedicated for leaders, from all sectors, who want to propel their professional development without putting their careers on hold. The faculty is composed of thought leaders, top experts and researchers from around the world.

PGD and CiL are designed and delivered in collaboration with Aalto University Executive Education and Professional Development (Finland).
