UONGOZI INSTITUTE TO HOLD THE FIRST-EVER FORUM FOR ITS ALUMNI

1 August 2025, Dar es Salaam: UONGOZI Institute will hold the first-ever forum for its alumni at the Dar es Salaam Serena Hotel, today. **Eng. Zena Ahmed Said**, Chief Secretary and Secretary of Revolutionary Council of the Revolutionary Government of Zanzibar, will officiate the event.

The keynote address will be delivered by Mr. Omari Issa, Chancellor of the Nelson Mandela African Institution of Science and Technology.

The UONGOZI alumni network consists of leaders who have completed the Institute's long-term executive education programmes: Postgraduate Diploma in Leadership (PGD), Certificate in Leadership (CiL), and Women's Leadership Programme (WLP). The forum will mark the start of deliberate efforts to harness the power of this group to deliver on the Institute's mission. It is themed "Advancing transformative leadership in Africa: The role of UONGOZI alumni".

The three programmes aim to develop leadership competencies in personal leadership, people leadership and organisational leadership. They are dedicated for leaders, from all sectors, who want to propel their professional development without putting their careers on hold. The faculty consists of experts in the field of leadership development from across the world.

PGD and CiL are designed and delivered in collaboration with Aalto University Executive Education and Professional Development (Finland). They are implemented with support from the governments of Tanzania and Finland. The WLP receives support from the two governments as well as the European Union.
